Name of Program: Opioid Overdose Recovery Program (OORP)

Purpose: This Request for Proposals (RFP) sought to develop an Opioid Overdose Recovery Program to respond to individuals reversed from opioid overdoses and treated at hospital emergency departments as a result of the reversal. DMHAS, the Governor’s Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (GCADA) and the Department of Children and Families (DCF) will provide total annualized funding of \$1,023,000 for two (2) years. Four (4) contracts in the amount of \$255,750 each were awarded in Camden, Essex, Monmouth and Ocean County.

The Opioid Overdose Recovery Program will utilize Recovery Specialists and Patient Navigators to engage individuals reversed from an opioid overdose to provide non-clinical assistance, recovery supports and appropriate referrals for assessment and substance use disorder treatment. The Recovery Specialists and Patient Navigators will also maintain follow-up with these individuals. It is planned that, at minimum, recovery specialists will be accessible and on-call from Thursday evenings through Monday mornings.
