# Special Enrollment period

- Must happen within three months of a Qualifying Life Event (QLE):
  - Loss of health coverage
    - Losing existing health coverage, including job-based, individual, and student plans.
    - Losing eligibility for Medicare, Medicaid, or CHIP.
    - Turning 26 and losing coverage through a parent's plan.

# Special Enrollment period- QLE

- Changes in household
  - Getting married or divorced
  - Having a baby or adopting a child
  - Death in the family
- Changes in residence
  - Moving to a different ZIP code or county
  - A student moving to or from the place they attend school
  - A seasonal worker moving to or from the place they both live and work
  - Moving to or from a shelter or other transitional housing

# Special Enrollment period- QLE

- Other qualifying events
  - Changes in income that affect the coverage a person may qualify for
  - Gaining membership in a federally recognized tribe or status as an Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA) Corporation shareholder
  - Becoming a U.S. citizen
  - Leaving incarceration (jail or prison)
  - AmeriCorps members starting or ending their service

# Copays and Deductibles Processing

- There are 101 beneficiaries on HIPP that qualify to receive assistance with copays and deductibles.
- Provider must submit bills directly to HIPP staff for processing and payment.
